

Executive Committee Meeting Summary
January 23, 2009

The Executive Committee approved the minutes of the September meeting and November conference call, adopted an Anti-trust Policy, and heard a report of the survey sent to chapter advisors in November, with communication and publications rated as most important.

A newsletter is being developed with projected website publication by March 31. It is hoped that the newsletter and increased communication with the chapters will generate interest in and submissions for a journal-style publication in 2010.

The Scholarship application deadline was established as April 3, 2009. A total of four scholarships may be awarded, as funding permits and the number and quality of applications warrant: two for foreign study, one for domestic study, one for language in community service. Additional smaller prizes, such as for the best article in a Society publication, may be added later.

Criteria for chartering and installing new chapters was discussed. A new application form and notification letters will be developed in accordance with The ACHS Guidelines for Chartering Chapters for discussion in the April conference call.
